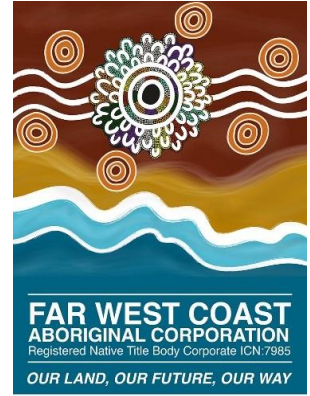


# Individual Sporting Policy and Application form

## INDIVIDUAL SPORTING POLICY

### - INTERPRETATION

The aim of the individual sporting grant is for registered members of the Far West Coast Aboriginal Corporation (FWCAC) that live in South Australia and have been selected to participate at regional, state or national level competition. Sporting grants for gifted athletes (International level) is available for registered members but will be considered Exceptional Individuals and Leadership Development. The aim is to assist registered members of the FWCAC living in South Australia and Aboriginal people who live in the Native Title Area, who are unable to meet the full costs, to participate and engage in higher level sporting activities and be afforded the opportunity to be successful and supported to reach their full potential.

Applications will be subject to the policy and funding criteria at the time the application is lodged.

### - WHO CAN APPLY?

The Far West Coast Aboriginal Corporation can support registered FWC members as well as Aboriginal people who have lived on the Native Title holding community for at least 10 years. An Aboriginal person who is not a member, lives outside the Native Title determination area but within South Australia, must have their FWC Native Title rights qualified by the FWCAC board prior to receiving any assistance from FWC and must also meet the mandatory criteria documented below.

Any person who is the primary carer of a FWC eligible child under the age of 18 years.

This application is restricted to South Australia only.

### - WHAT TYPES OF MATTERS MAY BE FUNDED?

- Travel expenses for individuals representing their region, state and/or nation.
- Accommodation will only be supported if travel for the event is more than 350kms from your registered address.
- Parents and/or care givers are expected to make a contribution towards the cost of travel and event.
- Funding limits will apply and subject to funding if the application is in line with the policy. Applicants are expected to contribute towards the cost of the event.
- This application is capped at \$300 once per financial year per registered member and child.

### - WHAT TYPES OF MATTERS WILL NOT BE FUNDED?

- Any person applying on behalf of a FWC eligible child who is not the primary carer of that child.
- Reimbursement of costs already paid by or on behalf of the applicant.
- Vehicle repairs, registration, and maintenance.
- Individual applications to attend State Aboriginal sporting carnivals (events held annually) including budgies netball, nunga next gen carnival, Maralinga cup.
- Participation in local sports competitions.
- Cash payments will not be made.
- Self-identification documentation and or passports.
- Overseas travel insurance to attend representative sport.

## **INDIVIDUAL SPORTING APPLICATION**

### **- MANDATORY CRITERIA**

In considering and assessing applications, the Far West Coast Aboriginal Corporation requires applicants to meet all the mandatory criteria set out in its FWC Application for Assistance Funding Policy.

### **- APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

Applications for funding must:

- Be in writing and in the approved form as provided by the Far West Coast Aboriginal Corporation.
- Be submitted in person, to the mailbox or email address on the application form.
- Identify any other funding that has been accessed or applied for.
- Be submitted at least 2 weeks prior to the event. Applications should be submitted as soon as notification is received for the event.
- Provide proof of selection for individuals participating in regional, state and national events.
