#### 3. Request for Quotes

3.1 The Far West Mining & Civil seeks a Tender for the sale of various vehicles.

3.2 All prices are to be lump sum and fixed. Tendered prices must **include** GST and all applicable duties, taxes and charges.

3.3 If successful, the Tenderer is responsible, at their cost, to arrange for removal of the vehicle/s and obtain any necessary licences required.
